<p>Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS)</p>	<p>Tourism & Hospitality Recovery Program: - revenue reduction of 40% or more -wage & rent subsidies of 40% to 75% October 24, 2021 to March 12, 2022 (equal to decline of revenue) -reduced by half March 12, 2022- May 7, 2022</p>
<p>Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy (CERS)</p>	<p>Hardest-Hit Business Recover Program: -not eligible under Tourism & Hospitality program - revenue reduction of 50% or more - wage & rent subsidies of 10% to 50% October 24,2021 to March 12, 2022 (50% decline = 10% subsidy increasing to 75% or higher decline = 50% subsidy) --reduced by half March 12, 2022- May 7, 2022</p> <p>*Lockdown support of 25% will continue *Proposed amendments to increase monthly cap from \$300,000 to \$1M</p>
<p>Canada Recovery Hiring Program (CRHP)</p>	<p>Continued, was set to expire November 20,2021 but will continue to May 7, 2022 - Revenue decline of 10% or more - increase subsidy rate to 50% until May 7, 2022</p>
<p>Canada Recovery Benefit (CRB)</p>	<p>Ended Canada Worker Lockdown Benefit: -\$300/week for workers subject to public health lockdowns</p>
<p>Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit (CRSB)</p>	<p>Continued, no change New proposed end date = May 7, 2022</p>
<p>Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefits (CRCB)</p>	<p>Continued, no change. New proposed end date = May 7, 2022</p>
<p>Employment Insurance (EI) September 26, 2021- November 20, 2021 minimum payment =\$300</p>	<p>No changes announced.</p>
